



We distributed some seeds today in Tanzania that Trenton Crossing helped assemble. Some of those seeds were given to an orphanage that houses 35 children. The garden there is doing well, and your seeds are going to be used to start another section with 5 more rows to help give the children a larger variety of foods.

From Clint - HHI Hunger to Harvest Director:

Yes. It is truly a life-changing thing for them and me. There are sometimes no words to express the feelings and emotions involved. For them, they see someone giving freely. They see someone giving them seeds and the opportunity to eat something they haven't had in a while - plus a variety of options. They cannot see the amount of people

that are involved in getting us here and to the point of distributing the gift. For them to know that people around the world packed these seeds and prayed over them and prayed for the people that were to receive them - it's a joy for all of us!

The pictures are of different gardens in the Endamarieki Village, Africa. This area also has a great Women of Hope program. Seeing it was unbelievable! Women who sell clothing they make to support themselves, their families, and the church. Super cool!














