Church News

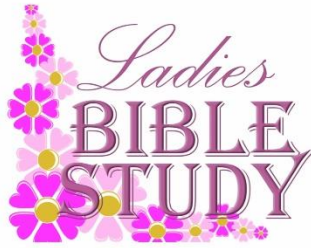

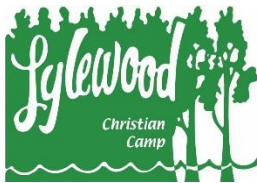

Dear Church Family,

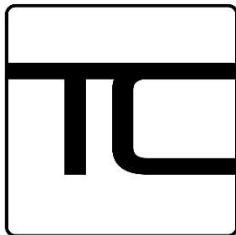
