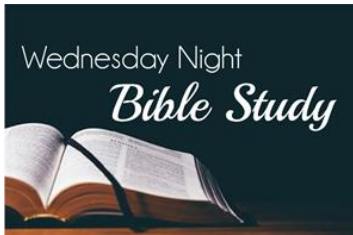

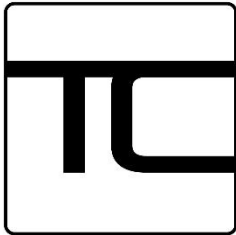
The class size is limited to 20 people and the cost is \$25 per person. The fee is due by December 29.
